Examination questions

PART A:

Several governments, international sport federations, NGOs and the UN have been working together since the beginning of the millennium to mainstream SDP policy initiatives around the world. The result of this has been the revision of many sport organizations' programs to include SDP.

In your role as an SDP manager/consultant, what would you recommend for incorporating SDP programs to ensure organisational sustainability. Be guided by the following questions:

- Begin by indicating the name, type (plus port or sport plus) and level (international, national, or local) of the sport organization you serve as the sport manager.
- Explain why mainstreaming SDP is so important?
- What factors should be considered in order to ensure sustainable SDP programs?
- How can SDP models that undermine organizational objectives be avoided?

The answer must be written in the form of an essay. This must not be shorter than 1400 words nor longer than 1500 words, excluding references.

PART B:

In recent years, there is a strong recommendation for SDP programs to focus on the social and ecological dimensions of sustainable development. Does this mean that the economic dimension should be ignored? With reference to the four pillars of the socio-ecological approach, explain why the recommendation is very crucial. This part must not be shorter than 1000 words nor longer than 1200 words, excluding references.

PART C

Assume that your community has recently decided to go green through sport. In an introduction between 200 and 300 words, briefly describe the location and the environmental/green needs of your community. Then answer the following questions in relation to your community needs:

Part C.1.:

As part of ensuring community sustainability, identify and explain in detail one sustainability strategy of your choice. The explanation should include at least four Sustainable Development Goals in relation to the Wedding Cake Model. Refer to Part C of Module 3 for your choice of the sustainability strategy. (Word limit should not be shorter than 800 words nor longer than 1000 words)

Part C.2.:

Describe in detail four managerial factors that should be considered to sustain the community sport programs. Refer to Part B of Module 4 in order to answer this part. (Word limit: Not shorter than 800 words nor longer than 1000 words).
