The exam paper has a 2500-word limit, excluding references, tables, figures and a front page, with 12 p Times New Roman, double line spacing and APA-standard of referencing. You are free to answer the exam in English or Norwegian.

The front page should entail the title of the paper, candidate number, course number and course name, semester and date.

You are free to decide the structure of the paper yourself, but it is expected that the paper has a logical structure. And it should include an introduction, main part and a conclusion.

You should refer to research literature and the curriculum, but practical experience can also be of value. However, papers only based on personal opinions or that does not make use of any curriculum will <u>not</u> generate a good grade.

Grade: The grades will be A-F, where F is fail.

Pick <u>one</u> of the two tasks below, and make sure that you follow the instructions for formatting and referencing:

- Write a report for a local club (from a sport of your choosing) on how they can
 prevent dropout within their club. The report should focus on dropout in general and
 have some concrete practical suggestions for the club setting on how to prevent it.
- 2) A sports federation (from a sport of your choosing) contacts you because they want more information about talent development systems. They have asked you to write a report about this topic and how it relates to aspects such as dropout and talent development.
