








Herston campus

Just three kilometres from the Brisbane city centre, UQ Herston is the specialist campus for health and medical teaching and research.

Gatton campus

Our rural campus is located near the town of Gatton, just over an hour's drive west of the Brisbane's city centre.

Getting to UQ

UQ St Lucia

- 7km from the Brisbane CBD
- 15 minutes between each CityCat Ferry
- 10+ direct bus routes with a bus arriving every two minutes at the UQ Lakes bus stop
- Easily accessible by bike or walking.

UQ Gatton

- 5km from Gatton CBD
- 1 hour from Brisbane
- Free buses between St Lucia and Gatton campuses leave at regular intervals each day during semester.

UQ Herston

- 5km from Brisbane CBD
- 2 minutes by bus from Brisbane CBD
- 3+ train stations within 2km




Entrepreneurship and Innovation

Guaranteed accommodation for international students

Guaranteed accommodation is available to new international students who are commencing at either St Lucia or Herston campuses.

Eligibility:

- Be commencing as an international student at UQ
- Have accepted your offer of study
- Be living alone we do not provide guaranteed accommodation to couples or families

Submit an application for **Guaranteed Accommodation** and secure your accommodation before you arrive in Brisbane.




Approved providers

- All utilities included in the weekly rent






UQ Res

Independent student accommodation owned by The University of Queensland and operated by UQ Residences within the St Lucia campus.

What can you expect from **UQ Res**:

- Spacious rooms, all fully-furnished
- Engaging <u>student life program</u>
- Minutes from your classes
- Music rooms, cinemas and games rooms
- All utilities included in the weekly rent





Residential colleges

There are 11 on-campus residences across St Lucia (10) and Gatton (1) campuses


- Some are co-educational and others are single gender
- On-site support and activities
- Most colleges provide full catering for students; some self-catering options are available for postgraduate students
- Walking distance to university facilities





Private rental options

- Lower cost option
- Rent will be based on the location, size, inclusions and amenities
- May be furnished or unfurnished
- May be managed by a private owner or real-estate agent
- You can rent a whole house/apartment or just a room
- Always inspect property before paying money or signing a lease agreement
- Book one to two weeks short term accommodation when you arrive so you have time to inspect properties
- UQ Accommodation maintains the UQ Rentals database





Airport pickup

The University of Queensland will arrange transportation from the Brisbane Domestic or International Airports for new UQ international students.

To arrange airport pick-up, you will need to provide:

- Minimum of 3 working days notice
- Date of flight, flight time and flight number
- Full drop-off address, including unit and street number
- Number of persons accompanying you
- Luggage and other relevant details

As a Study Abroad student, you can study at UQ for one or two semesters and can transfer the credit earned back to your home university degree.

Students can come from any accredited overseas university.


